## Principal's Corner

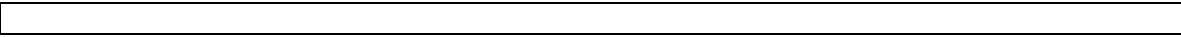
Parent conferences/Report Card Pick-up is scheduled for Thursday, September 29, from 3:30pm – 6:30pm. It is mandatory that all report cards be picked up by the parents or guardians. They will not be issued to anyone else. This is a time for conversations with the classroom teacher concerning your child's progress and ways you can help. It is also a time to address any concerns or questions you may have concerning your child and LWCA.



If these concerns or questions are not addressed at the conference, there is a parent concern form located in Office #1. Please feel free to fill out that form and you will be contacted.

This year we are revamping our “Honor Roll” categories. The category referred to as the “A” Honor Roll is now the “SUPER HONOR ROLL”. Students must receive A’s in all core subject areas: Reading, Math, Science, Bible and Social Studies. In addition, students can receive B’s in other subject areas such as: Writing, Library, P.E., Spanish and Music. They can receive no C’s.

The category formally referred to as the “B” Honor Roll is now the HONOR ROLL. Students must receive an A in both Reading and Math. Students can receive B’s in the rest of the core subject areas: Bible, Science, Social Studies and Writing. In addition, students can only receive one C and it is limited to the following subjects: Library, Spanish, P.E., and Music – they cannot receive a “C” in any core subject area.
